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

Xello's PIMS Career Readiness Indicator Report

This report allows educators to export a list of students and the status of their PIMS requirements.

The report links each of the standards as indicated by Pennsylvania's Career Education and Work Standard (Chapter 339) to one or more Xello lessons. Once students complete one of the associated lessons, they will be marked with a "Y" for completion in that column of the report. The PIMS report is set up by Xello and customized for your district. It is available from district, middle, and high school educator accounts.

How to Export the Report

- In your account, click on Reports in the menu on the left and then select PIMS Career Readiness Indicator Report.
- **2.** Here you'll find PIMS requirements, along with the corresponding Xello lesson(s) where students fulfill that requirement.
 - Some requirements may have multiple ways that students can fulfill it. Students only need to complete one of the correlated lessons to complete the requirement.
- **3.** From here you can **Export all grades**, or Select one or more grades to export.
 - The exported report will have the students' information, their total number of logins, along with a column for each PIMS requirement. The PIMS columns will have a Y/N indicating if the student has fulfilled that requirement.
